

How to edit your own writing?

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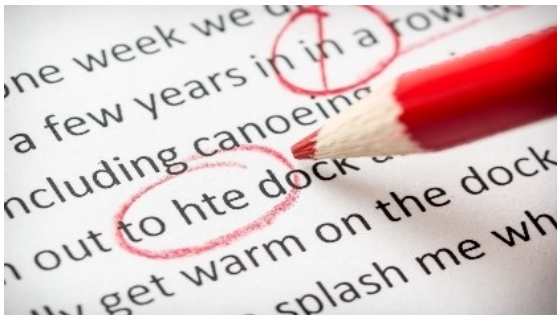

2. Get a print out

3. Change locations

Take a print of your piece and look at the copy in another place where you can relax, like a garden or an open terrace. A change in location makes a big difference.

5. Grammar check

6. Spelling check

Lastly, run a spell check as it takes only a couple of seconds. Don't unnecessarily use punctuation and italics as they weaken the growing impact of your article.

7. Ask for help
