


How to talk about your dream job?

This is a great way of showing your career values and culture together with the current company's culture and values. You can make your responses like:

3. Talk about your interests

In this point, you can say how you found an interest to a specific industry. Try giving some examples or any real-life experiences that might have happened in your school or college days. Build your response like below answers.

Example:

I have been interested in the __ industry ever since I first discovered __. That, combined with my interest in __ and __ means I have been enthusiastic ever since.
