

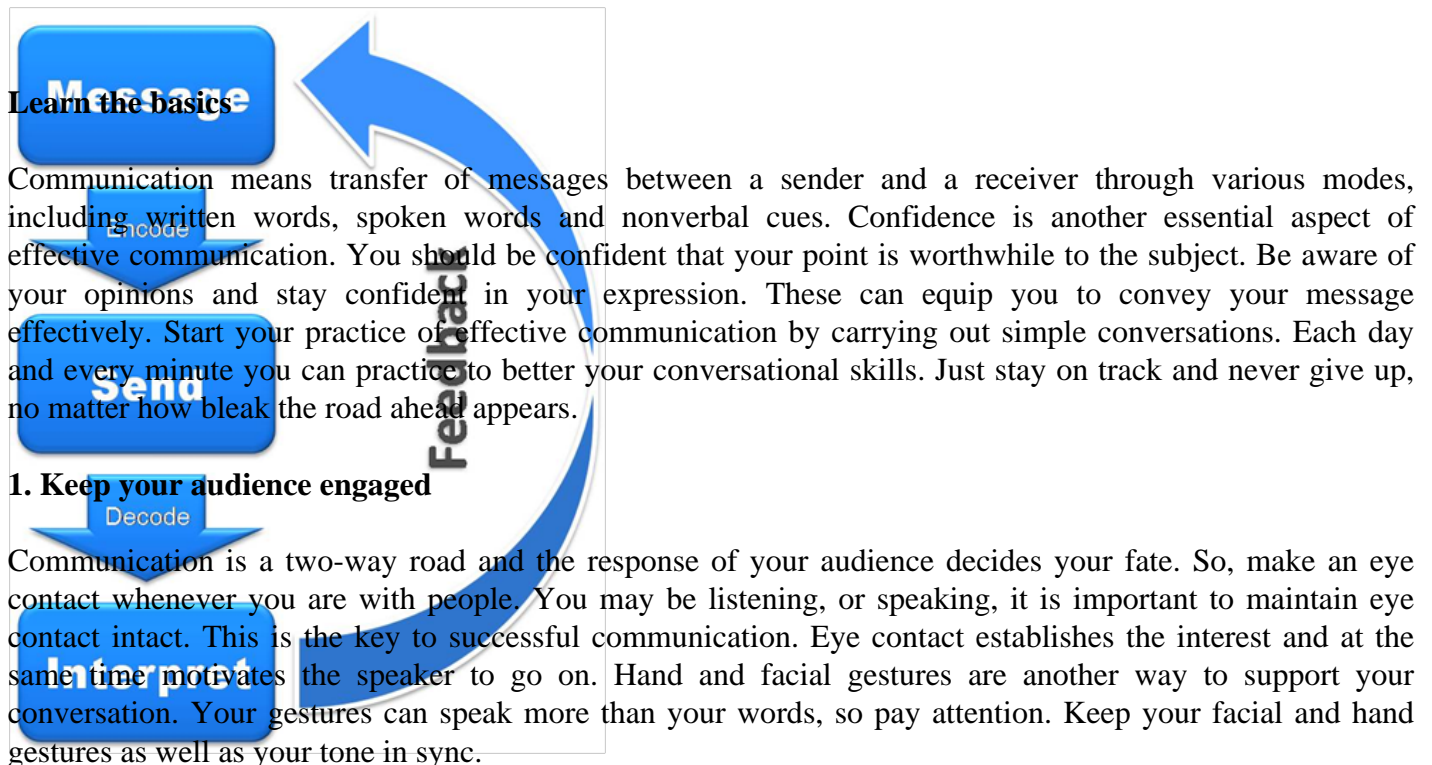
How to Improve Communication Skills?
